Do you own your own home and need some repairs done in and around the house?
Ever wish there was a program that could help with these repairs at no cost to you?

Well there is. Rebuilding Together Ingham County, previously known as Christmas in April, is a volunteer organization that identifies eligible homes of low-income seniors or low-income disabled persons for a one day home repair volunteer blitz that takes place the last Saturday in April.

Your home may be eligible. Here are the criteria:

- **Own and reside in the home**
- **Property taxes are up-to-date**
- **Homeowner's insurance is current**
- **Income at or below \$1361 per month for a one-person household or \$1839 per month for a two person household.**
- **You are disabled or 60 years of age or older**
- **Homeowner plans to be in home for at least two years**
- **Are able to be at your home on April 28, 2012**

To apply, complete an application with a list of repairs and submit it to Rebuilding Together Ingham County by January 20, 2012.

Your home may be one of the 20 + selected this year in the Greater Lansing Area. Repairs will be done by volunteers on Saturday, April 28, 2012. There is no cost to eligible homeowners who are selected.

Applications are available by calling 517-214-8356 (voice mail) and leaving a message requesting an application. Be prepared to state your first and last name and spell the last name, give a phone number, and a complete address. An application will be sent in December 2011 to apply for the 2012 Rebuilding Day Project.

Volunteer should also call 517-214-8356 (voicemail) and state your interest in becoming a volunteer. Please state your name and spell the last name and a complete address. A volunteer application will be sent to you. Donations are welcome. Any questions call the voice mail and leave a message. A board member will contact you.
